- 3. You will start your eye drops 3 days before ______ your surgery day. Put one drop in the eye to be operated on three times a day. Also, you <u>must</u> use your drops on the morning of your surgery.
- 4. Wash your face thoroughly the night before and the morning of your surgery. If the soap irritates your skin, please call. Do not get the soap in your eye. **Do not** wear eye makeup on the day of surgery.
- 5. If the eye drops irritate or make your eye red, please call the office to let us know.
- 6. If your surgery is scheduled in the morning, you may have **nothing by mouth after midnight.** If your surgery is scheduled in the afternoon, you may have a light breakfast of toast and clear juice **before 6:30 a.m.**
- 7. <u>Please take your regular medications</u> with a sip of water <u>the morning of surgery.</u> If you take insulin for diabetes, please only take one-half of the long acting insulin and **none** of the short acting. Also, if you take oral medication for diabetes, **do not take** them until after your surgery.
