LASIK PRE-OP INSTRUCTIONS

1. You must have a responsible adult with you the day of surgery. You must have someone stay with you the night after your surgery.

2. You must see one of our doctors the day after your surgery. Take your regular morning medications (if any) with breakfast with the following exceptions: o Accutane four (4) weeks prior to surgery. Restart Accutane four (4) weeks after surgery. If you are taking Amiodarone, you are not a LASIK candidate. Please check with your medical doctor before making any changes in your medications.

3. Remove eye makeup thoroughly the night prior to surgery. Do not wear eye makeup, earrings, nail polish, perfume, cologne, after-shave, hair spray, scented deodorant or anything that has a fragrance, as this will affect the laser beam's treatment on your eye! Leave all jewelry and valuables at home. Do not wear your hair in a ponytail or braid.

4. Do not wear soft contact lenses in the operative eye(s) for 3 days prior to evaluation and surgery.

5. Do not wear hard or gas permeable contact lenses in the operative eye(s) for 3 weeks prior to evaluation and surgery.

6. It is recommended that you eat a light breakfast before coming for your surgery. Be sure to have your prescription filled before the surgery and bring the medication with you when you report to the laser center. Please use the Besivance, if prescribed, 3 days prior to surgery. Use Restasis, if prescribed by your doctor, 3 days prior to surgery.

7. Plan on being at the laser center for about 2 hours.
